Who should apply

- Science educators providing professional development for middle-school teachers.
- Teachers using or planning to use FOSS Populations and Ecosystems in their classrooms.

Schedule

August 6, Wednesday, 9-4:30 at LHS. A group dinner is provided at LHS following the workshop.

August 7, Thursday, 9-4:30 at LHS. Dinner is on your own.

August 8, Friday, depart for Mono Lake via **Yosemite National Park**, arriving in the afternoon. All food is on your own.

August 9, Saturday, Mono Lake canoeing and birdwatching, picnic lunch in the afternoon, and group dinner in the evening.

August 10, Sunday, return to Berkeley via **South Lake Tahoe**, arriving in Berkeley in evening. All food is on your own.

- Drive-through and lunch in Yosemite National Park and South Lake Tahoe

Lodging

- Mono Lake: A block of various-sized rooms will be reserved for August 8-9 at **two hotels in Lee Vining, CA**. After we receive your registration, you will receive a list of rooms available and their cost. First come, first served! State that you are with the UC Berkeley FOSS Project. You will pay the hotel directly for your stay.

Meals

- LHS: Morning refreshments and lunch will be provided on Wednesday and Thursday. There will be a group dinner at the Lawrence Hall of Science Bay View Cafe on Wednesday evening.
- Mono Lake: A box picnic lunch will be provided on Saturday. There will be a group dinner on Saturday evening at the Mono Inn. All other meals (including travel snacks) will be your responsibility. There are a variety of restaurants in Berkeley as well as in Lee Vining.

Transportation

- Transportation via van to and from Mono Lake is included in the registration. The vans will leave from and return to the Doubletree Hotel.
